2010 BUDGET

SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ASSUMPTIONS

Services Provided

In accordance with its Service Plan, Sweetgrass Metropolitan District No. 2 (the "District") was formed to finance public roadway, drainage, and park services and facilities for the residential component of the "Sweetgrass" P.U.D., located in Dacono, Colorado. The Service Plan of the District limits the debt and general mill levy of the District.

In 2009, the District voters approved debt authorization of \$28,450,000 in general obligation bonds for District No. 2, to be used for district formation costs and costs of infrastructure. The District has not issued any general obligation debt to date in 2009, but may issue general obligation debt late in 2009 or in 2010.

The District prepares its budget on the modified accrual basis of accounting, and the budget has been adopted after proper postings, publications and public hearing.

Revenue

Property taxes

The only source of revenue for the District is property taxes. The District adopted a mill levy of 40.00 for debt service and 10.00 for operations and maintenance for the collection of ad valorem taxes for 2010.

Expenditures

Administrative

Administrative expenditures have been estimated based upon the level of expenditures incurred by the District in prior years

Transfers to District No. 1

The District is obligated to transfer all of its net revenue to District No. 1, for the payment of debt service and allocated administrative costs.

Leases

The District has no operating or capital leases.
